## SAC HIGH CELEBRATES 150 YEARS

Established in 1856, Sacramento High School is the second oldest high school west of the Mississippi River.

Who is the oldest high school you ask? Lowell High School in San Francisco was established just a few weeks earlier as the first public secondary school in California.

Beginning with just 21 boys and 18 girls, the one-room school was located on M St. between 8th and 9th. After making a move to a second location on 7th and G St., Sac-

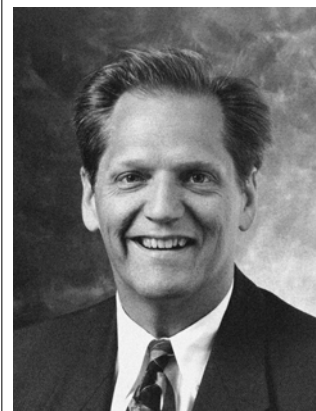
