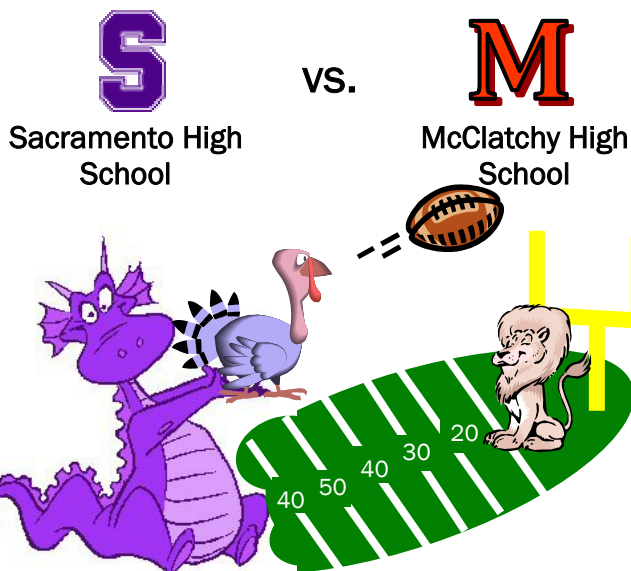

successful as they finished the year with a 29-6 record, beating three Sac- Joaquin Section champions (Tokay, Jesuit and Modesto Christian) along the way. After winning the Capital Athletic League, the Dragons lost a heartbreaker for the NorCal Championships by losing 37-35 to St. Mary's of Stockton.
