Alumni of the Month - Councilmember Robbie Waters

A native Sacramentan, Robbie Waters was born in 1936 and graduated from Sacramento High School in 1954. After completing his tour of duty with the U.S. Air Force in 1957, he became a member of the Sacramento Police Department in the Patrol Division in September 1958.

Robbie was elected Sheriff of Sacramento County in 1982, and held the position until 1987. He received numerous awards during his years of service to our community.

Proud Graduate of 1954

He holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminology from California State University at Sacramento and is a graduate of the FBI National Academy in Advanced Criminology. He was elected to the Sacramento City Council in November 1994 and re-elected for a second term in June 1998. Robbie was re-elected for another four-year term as District Seven Councilmember in March 2002 and is running for a fourth four-year term after serving the constituents of District Seven for the past 11 years.
